

Derby Night at the 2012 Royal

**The \$50,000 Canadian Hunter Derby
Championships**

for the Lorna Jean Guthrie Challenge Trophy



The 16 top 3'6" horses in the Canadian Hunter Derby Series from across the country will be invited to compete. Selection of horses is based on points accumulated in the Canadian Hunter Derby Series and split between East (Quebec and Ontario) and West (Alberta and British Columbia) qualifying regions based on prize money offered:

- Top 11 entries from the East (top 20 East ranking required). Quebec guaranteed at least 2 of 11 East entries (top 4 Quebec ranking required)
- Top 5 entries from the West (top 10 West ranking required)
- The organizing committee reserves 2 **Wild Cards**
- If 16 entries do not meet the above criteria (top 20 in the East/top 10 West), remaining spots reserved by the organizing committee as additional **Wild Cards**

Details

- Maximum 2 horses per rider
- A change of ownership will not affect qualification
- All horses must have a valid passport
- Standings are tracked at www.hunterderby.ca
- Final Royal accepted entries will be posted at www.royalfair.org
- A wait list of 10 will be maintained until October 31st.

Competitors in the East top 20 and top 10 in the West are encouraged to send in their entries by the Royal Winter Fair's entry deadline to ensure they are eligible for consideration.

Canadian Hunter Derby Championship

The cumulative high point horse in the two classes will be awarded the Lorna Jean Guthrie Challenge Trophy as the Canadian Hunter Derby Champion. Higher placed horse in the Knightwood to break ties. The trophy will be retired by a horse winning 3 derby championships.

The 2012 3'6 high point horses from the East and West Canadian Hunter Derby Series will be honoured as Regional Champions between derbies at the 2012 Royal
